#### **Who we serve**

Located in a peaceful, home-like setting, Prototypes' Oxnard campus is equipped to provide treatment and housing for up to 56 women and 29 children\* at any one time, in an environment that is ideally suited for clients to heal themselves and their families as they rebuild their lives. The clients who come to Prototypes are women age 18 and over whose lives have been disrupted by trauma, drug and/or alcohol addiction, domestic violence, mental health conditions, complex medical conditions, anger management problems and even homelessness. Many of our clients are also mothers, or expectant mothers, who want to keep their babies and young children with them while they undergo treatment in residence. We totally agree and welcome them, too.

#### **Who we are**

Prototypes staff include some of the most dedicated, experienced, highly trained professionals in the field – psychiatrists, certified substance abuse counselors, licensed mental health clinicians, job development counselors, housing specialists and parenting specialists.

#### **What we offer**

Everything we do – from therapy to life skills education to vocational training and beyond – is designed to maximize a woman's chances for a healthy, self-sustaining life. We offer:

- Individualized treatment and assessment
- Detoxification
- Life Balance Program for women in school or working
- Individual and group counseling
- Psychiatric evaluation and treatment
- Medication assisted therapies
- Vocational and educational rehabilitation
- Parenting skills classes
- Family counseling
- Aftercare
- Family accommodation, along with intensive services for children
- Treatment designed for women:
  - Trauma-informed
  - Gender-responsive
  - Evidence-based
- Treatment for co-occurring substance use and mental health disorders so that multiple issues can be addressed in a single treatment program
- Recreational activities and other support services as needed
- Specialized programs for women involved in the criminal justice system

Treatment durations vary based on client need. All treatment plans are highly individualized, and the length and intensity of treatment is based on those individual needs.
